*Pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes § 42-3-115(2)-The transferee may operate a motor vehicle on the highway before registering it if: (III) (A) the transferee has purchased the motor vehicle within the last thirty-six hours from a person who is not a motor vehicle dealer... (B) the vehicle was purchased either on a Saturday, on a Sunday, on a legal holiday or between 5 p.m. and 8 a.m. (C) the vehicle is being driven from the place where the transferor stored the vehicle to the place where the transferee intends to store the vehicle; (D) The owner possesses, in the vehicle, a bill of sale that shows the time and date of sale and that is signed by both the buyer and seller AND (E) the owner possesses, in the vehicle, proof of insurance as required...*
